The LaSalle Police Central Communications Centre provides emergency dispatch and communication services 24 hours a day, 365 days a year to the LaSalle Police Service, LaSalle Fire Service and Kingsville Fire Service.

The LaSalle Police Service is currently seeking applications for the position of permanent part-time Dispatcher.

This demanding position requires a high functioning individual who can receive, assess and relay information in an accurate, expeditious and courteous manner. Applicants must be willing to work on short notice at any hour of the day or night including weekdays and/or weekends.

Preferred qualifications include:

- Strong two way communication skills;
- Attention to detail;
- Training and/or experience in public safety;
- Practical computer knowledge and experience; and
- Efficient keyboarding/typing skills.

The recruitment process shall consist of application review, interviews, CritiCall 911 Dispatcher Assessment, hearing assessment and enhanced background check.
